To: MEMBERS OF THE RESIDENT FACULTY

The items listed below will be considered to have the necessary faculty approvals unless a petition requesting further consideration of specific items is signed by five faculty members and submitted to the chair of the Faculty Council within 14 calendar days after the date of circulation. If no petition is received within 14 days, the entire report will be submitted to the president for approval and transmittal to the regents, if regents action is required. If a petition is received, the items in the report for which further consideration is requested will be referred to the Faculty Council and the remainder of the report will move forward. On items referred to it, the council may: (1) affirm the action and report it to a meeting of the university faculty, (2) amend the action and report it to a meeting of the university faculty, or (3) rescind the action. NOTE: If a petition concerns courses or curricula in the College of L & S or in the College of Agriculture, and is signed by five faculty members of the respective college, those items will be returned to the college concerned for further consideration.

AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION

1. Add AgEd 252 Developing Organizations (1 cr). Assisting community, collegiate, or social organization members, officers, or committee chairs to better serve the organization and to acquire practical organizational and management skills that will help them throughout their academic and professional careers. [Fall 2000]
2. Add AgEd 253 Parliamentary Procedure (1 cr). Basic knowledge and skills related to parliamentary procedure and the orderly conduct of business in meetings. [Fall 2000]
3. Add AgEd 306 Exploring International Agriculture (2 cr). General overview of agriculture around the world and the opportunity to develop an in-depth knowledge of agriculture in a country or region of student's choice. [Fall 2000]

BUSINESS

Change the prerequisite to Bus 340, Team Building and Group Dynamics (2 cr), by adding Math 160 or 170. [Spring 2001]

Drop CE ID&WS544, Buckling in Structures (3 cr) [dormant]. [Summer 2000]

EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATION

1. Drop EdAd 506, Elementary Educational Administration (3 cr) [dormant]. [Summer 2000]

2. Drop EdAd 508, Secondary Educational Administration (3 cr) [dormant]. [Summer 2000]

MECHANICAL ENGINEERING

1. Change the credits of ME 262, Sophomore Laboratory, from "2 cr" to "3 cr." [Spring 2001]

2. Drop ME R537, Advanced Fluid Mechanics (2-3 cr) [dormant]. [Fall 2000]

MICROBIOLOGY, MOLECULAR BIOLOGY AND BIOCHEMISTRY

1. Change the credits and description of MMBB 400 to read [Spring 2001]:

MMBB 400 (s) Seminar (~~cr arr~~ 1 cr, max 4). Graded P/F. May be used as a science elective after 1 required credit, up to a maximum of 4 credits. Prereq: perm.

2. Change the description of MMBB J409/J509, Immunology (3 cr), by adding "Carries no credit after MMBB WS426." [Spring 2001]

3. Change the title and description of MMBB 497 to read [Spring 2001]:

MMBB 497 (s) Practicum in ~~Tutoring~~ Teaching (1 cr, max 2). ~~Tutorial services performed~~ Teaching by advanced students under faculty supervision. Graded P/F. Prereq: perm.

4. Add MMBB 590 Teaching Practicum (1 cr, max 2). Teaching by master's students under faculty supervision. Graded P/F. Prereq: perm. [Spring 2001]

5. Add MMBB 591 Teaching Practicum (1 cr, max 4). Teaching by Ph.D. students under faculty supervision. Graded P/F. Prereq: perm. [Spring 2001]

6. Drop MMBB 597 Practicum (cr arr). [Spring 2001]

RECREATION

1. Change the credits and description of Rec 275 to read [Fall 2001]:

Rec 275 Computer Applications in Leisure Services (~~2-er~~ 3 cr). Introduction to computer software applicable to the recreation and leisure profession; software used to produce presentation graphics, desktop publishing, spreadsheets, web page creation, and print material for the leisure profession; Internet access for electronic mail, and Web searches through web search engines; intro to SPSS statistical software. ~~One lec and one lab a wk.~~

2. Change the title and description of Rec 349 to read [Spring 2001]:

- Change the "additional courses selected from the following" from "5 cr" to "4 cr" and add Rec 299 and 499 to the list of electives.

4. Change the academic minor in recreational therapy as follows [Summer 2001]:

- Add Rec 330, Recreational Therapy Programming for People with Disabilities (3 cr), and Rec 495, Practicum in Tutoring (1 cr).
- Drop "approved electives" (2-3 cr).
- Change Rec 280, Recreation Practicum, from "2 cr" to "1 cr."
